The minutes of the regular meeting held September 6, 2022, were read by Chairman Beverly Haar. DJ Greenhill moved and Jerry Haar seconded that the minutes be approved. **Motion carried.**

FINANCIAL

A motion was made by Trustee Greenhill and seconded by Trustee J. Haar that the attached list of bills totaling \$53,810.77 be approved as the lawful obligations of Harris Township and that the Fiscal Officer be permitted to issue warrants in favor of the same. **Motion carried**.

The Fiscal Officer presented the July and August 2022 financial reports and bank reconciliation reports. After review, a motion to approve the July and August 2022 financial reports and bank reconciliations was made by Greenhill and seconded by B. Haar. **Motion carried.**

Zoning: (Inspector's report)

- 1. The Zoning Appeals Board held a final hearing for Hawn appeal and approved the setback.

Cemetery: (Sexton's report)

Roads: (Road Superintendent's report)

- John Deere Alamo long reach mower is being repaired at a quoted cost of \$2,250 at Oak Harbor Hydraulic for hydraulic cable replacements. PO to be issued from Fund RDS2031.
- 2. Trustees remain interested in purchasing a used Durapatcher from Clay Township PD for \$18,000. Additional costs would include \$900 for a cold sheet door on truck. Supt. will review specifics/price and bring back to next meeting for a decision.
- 3. L. J. Overmyer expressed concerns about a drainable tile below surface on Smith Road. He was instructed to contact the County regarding concerns before any boring is done under the road.
- 4. Received invitation to ODOT 2024 STIP Rural Consultation Virtual Meeting on Oct. 18.
- 5. Supt. Johnson will need to schedule his ODOT physical.

6. Discussion on recent tar/chip project on Linker-Portage Rd and Lickert-Harder Rd. Trustees to discuss with contractor, Bergman, and County Engineer's office before fog seal is placed.

EMS/Fire: (Chief's report)

- 1. Rocky Ridge Fire Department is disbanding and auctioning its equipment. B. Haar motioned and Greenhill seconded giving permission to purchase fittings and other items that will be useful for HEFD.
- 2. Reimbursement was approved to Greenhill for purchase of inflatable boat for fire department. The boat had to be purchased on a credit card showing a street address as opposed to a PO box number. Purchase order to be issued for \$1,798 FIRE2282-760-740-0000.
- 3. Notification received: MARCS radios were shipped and will have to be installed by PRN.
- 4. James Hauden and Jeffrey Harwick have accepted part-time EMT positions. B. Haar moved and Greenhill seconded hiring Baylee Tefft for part-time EMT-B position pending background and BMV checks. **Motion carried.**
- 5. Greenhill moved and J. Haar seconded EMS preventative maintenance costs and issuance of purchase orders for:
 - a. Stryker power cots and stair chair, \$1,452
 - b. Zoll renewal for 2 autopulse and 2 monitors, \$1,500
 - c. VendNovation for EMS dispenser software licensing, \$1,200

- 4. Materion Brush Inc notification of modification received dated 9/12/2022.
