The minutes of the special meeting held September 28, 2022, were read by Chairman Beverly Haar. DJ Greenhill motioned and Beverly Haar seconded that the minutes be approved.

Motion carried.

The minutes of the regular meeting held November 7, 2022, were read by Chairman Beverly Haar. DJ Greenhill motioned and Jerry Haar seconded that the minutes be approved. **Motion carried.**

FINANCE

- A motion was made by Trustee Greenhill and seconded by Trustee J. Haar that the attached list of bills totaling \$32,731.80 be approved as the lawful obligations of Harris Township and that the Fiscal Officer be permitted to issue warrants in favor of the same. Motion carried.
- 2. Trustees reviewed invoices, signed checks and vouchers, reviewed and initialed payroll, reviewed and signed purchase authorizations.

REPORTS

Financial/Administrative: (Fiscal Officer's report)

- 1. B. Haar moved and Greenhill seconded a donation of \$200 be given to the Ottawa County Community Foundation. The fire department has been the recipient of several grants from the organization in the past. **Motion carried.**
- 2. J. Haar motioned and B. Haar seconded that a \$1,250 donation be made to the Ottawa County Drug Task Force. **Motion carried.**
- 3. An employee has returned to light duty work after a medical leave.

Zoning: (Inspector's report)

1. Zoning inspector will be issued an ID to use when conducting township business. Discussion on magnetic vehicle signage; no action taken.

- 2. Some new residents to Harris Township are unaware that the township is zoned. B. Haar moved and Greenhill seconded to spent \$500 to purchase and post road signs at main roads entering township borders to help educate the public. **Motion carried.**
- 3. Permit applications pending for out building and new construction.

Cemetery: (Cemetery Sexton's report)

- 1. New deeds were issued: #671 through #674
- 2. Discussion on potential land acquisition from Mr. Richard Yeasting.
- 3. Wreaths across America delivery will be the week of Dec. 12, with ceremony scheduled for Saturday, Dec. 17.

Roads: (Road Superintendent's report)

- Discussion continues about oil baths to help preserve truck bodies, specifically the cemetery truck, new plow truck and backhoe. B. Haar abstained from the discussion. Trustees agreed with Johnson to put off until 2023 and look into other cost-saving opportunities with other townships.
- 2. Equipment repairs:
 - —'02 Freightliner's plow being rebuilt: 2 hydraulic cylinders being replaced; estimated cost of \$600-\$1000
 - —front-end loader's flat tire to be repaired with tube or replaced by Tri-County; estimated cost of \$250.
- 3. The first batch of the salt brine operation went well. Purchase of a multi-purpose chemical pump costing \$400 will be needed. Greenhill moved and J. Haar seconded purchasing the pump. **Motion carried.**
- 4. Durapatch machine being stored for Clay Township PD.
- 5. A resident on Martin Williston Road has a failing driveway culvert and is requesting a ditch cleaning by Harris and Sandusky counties because this is a joint county road. Before deciding, the trustees will file a TRQ with the Ottawa County Engineer to evaluate the scope and cost of such a project.

EMS/Fire: (Chief's report)

- 1. Engine 444 was taken to Williams for airline leaks; anticipated cost estimated at \$1000. Obtaining quotes for new tires for 444 (NFPA requirement every 10 years).
- 2. Pat & Sons Towing will be contacted again for removal of training trailer. Discussion on using township employees to tear down and dispose before winter if not removed soon.
- 3. Association working on updating their protocol manual to include explorer group.

Building & Grounds: (Jim Wilburn, building supervisor)

1. The toilet in the women's restroom needs a diaphragm replaced. Yackee Electric was called.

Announcements, Communications, Other

- 1. Another public meeting concerning wind/solar farms will be held at the Ottawa County Courthouse EOC on December 13 at 3:30 p.m.
- 2. October EMS billing reports have been received and reviewed from Great Lakes Billing.
- 3. An election ballot was received from OTARMA Board of Directors. No action taken.
- 4. Trustees reviewed copy of letter written to Commissioners from local homeowners requesting combining resources with Amplex for local internet service during the upcoming water main extension project on Portage River South Road.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Jerry Haar and seconded by DJ Greenhill. Chairman Beverly Haar declared the meeting duly adjourned at 9:40 pm.
